Wales Probation is holding a **one day workshop** for representatives of Welsh social enterprises who are interested in exploring these partnership and commercial opportunities.

The workshop is being held on the **6th of March** between 11am and 3pm at the SWALEC stadium in Cardiff. It will be attended by Wales Probation staff as well as representatives from other Probation and Criminal Justice organisations, such as the National Offender Management Service (NOMS), Welsh Prisons and the Probation Association.
